
36TH ANNUAL TREE PROGRAM ORDER FORM

Join the Village's reforestation efforts by ordering trees for fall planting in your yard. The trees are purchased through the Suburban Tree Consortium (STC), which is comprised of 30 municipalities in the western suburbs who banded together to contract with Wilson Nurseries, Of Hampshire, Illinois. Although there is no guarantee that accompanies the tree, mortality within the consortium has been approximately 1% in recent years.

Because the trees will be dormant at the time of delivery, conditions will be ideal for the development of a healthy root system. However, since deliveries are not until late October, residents are urged to plant their trees promptly after receiving them to avoid any danger of freezing or drying. Since the trees are grown locally, they are well-adjusted to soil conditions. Also, since they are balled and burlapped, the trees adapt more readily to their new location and do not require extensive pruning.

Please remember that under the provisions of the Village's tree regulations, a permit must be obtained if any of the trees purchased through this program are to be planted in the parkway. There is no fee for the permit; however, your application should be approved before you accept delivery.

As shown on the order form, the following trees will be available for purchase. Some quantities are limited and are first come, first serve. Pictures are available for inspection at the Village Hall:

Autumn Blaze Maple - 2.5" caliper - Height to 50 feet. Brilliant and long lasting orange red color. Broadly oval form with medium green foliage. This maple is fast growing and will benefit from pruning. **\$240**

Skyline Honeylocust - 2.5" caliper - Height from 35 to 50 feet. Rapid growing small leafed shade tree. Pyramidal form with dark green leaves turning to golden yellow in the fall. A tough tree, good for harsh sites. Salt tolerant. **\$255**

American Sentry Linden - 2.5" caliper - Height to 60 feet. Dense pyramidal form with dark green, heart-shaped leaves that turn yellow in fall. Fragrant flowers in June. Tolerant of harsh soil conditions. **\$265**

Morton Accolade Elm - 2.5" caliper - height from 40 to 60 feet. Upright to vase-shaped form. The Morton Arboretum introduced this cultivar through Chicagoland Grows. Good resistance to Dutch Elm disease, elm yellows and elm leaf beetle. Yellow fall color. **\$245**

Triumph Elm - 2.5" caliper - Height from 50 to 60 feet. Crown is upright to oval. Branches begin to arch as tree matures. Resistant to Dutch Elm disease and elm yellows; good resistance to elm leaf beetle. Adaptable to most soil types unless excessively wet. **\$245**

Emerald Green Arborvitae - 6 foot - Height to 15 feet; width to 4 feet. Narrow, pyramidal evergreen displaying dense emerald green foliage. Holds its foliage color throughout winter. Excellent medium to large hedge for screening. **\$155**

All trees are limited availability. Confirmation of order will be given within 2 business days of order receipt.

Orders must be placed no later than Friday, October 2nd, 2015. There is a delivery fee of \$10 per tree. Tree delivery will begin Wednesday, October 14th and trees will only be delivered to the driveway.
