Information Regarding Local Residential Burglaries

This bulletin is being sent to update Burr Ridge residents of information related to residential burglaries occurring in surrounding areas.

On February 3, 2016, Deputy Chief Loftus sent you an email on my behalf passing on information in reference to two residential burglaries that occurred in neighboring Willow Springs. Since the date of that email, five more residential burglaries have occurred in neighboring communities. Darien Police reported that they are investigating two residential burglaries that occurred on February 9, 2016. The DuPage Sheriff's Department is investigating two residential burglaries that occurred in unincorporated Tri-State Village on February 4 & 9, 2016. This morning I was informed of another residential burglary, again in Willow Springs, that occurred yesterday morning in the area of German Church & School Street. The suspect vehicle in that incident is a white Nissan Altima, license plate unknown. The video images below of the suspect vehicle was captured by video cameras on the victim's home.



Once again I am asking that you remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity immediately by calling 9-1-1. Also, please set your residential security alarms whenever you leave your home; even if it is for a short period of time. Please share this information with your neighbors.
