### **Information Regarding Local Residential Burglaries**

***This bulletin is being sent to notify Burr Ridge residents of information related to a residential burglary that occurred in Willow Springs, IL.***

On January 25, 2016 at approximately 12:20 PM, three offenders committed a burglary in Willow Springs by forcing entry to a rear door.

A similar burglary occurred two days later, on January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 between 7:30 Am and 2:50 pm in the 8100 block of Ridgepointe Drive.

Willow Springs released the following images of the suspect vehicle in the burglary committed in their town. The vehicle is described as a light colored Mercury Mariner with damage to the driver's side. Two offenders entered the home while one remained in the vehicle.



Residents are asked to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity immediately to the police by calling 9-1-1. Please set your alarms, even if leaving only for a short time.
