Burr Ridge Police Arrest Subject for Motor Vehicle Theft and Criminal Damage to Property

Burr Ridge Police have charged 46 year-old Tony Keorkunian of Justice, IL with Motor Vehicle Theft and Criminal Damage to Property after an attempted break in on August 26, 2015.

On August 26, 2015 at approximately 10:20 AM, Burr Ridge Officers responded to a report of an attempted residential burglary in the 15W200 Block of 59th Street. An offender described as a white male, shaved head, wearing a black jacket, short pants, and having tattoos on his legs, attempted to gain entry to the home through a ground floor window. The suspect fled the scene on foot westbound towards Madison Street.

Burr Ridge, Hinsdale, Indian Head Park, Clarendon Hills, and Willowbrook Police, along with a K-9 Officer from the Cook County Sheriff's Police searched the area for the offender. Nearby Elm School was contacted and asked to implement their planned safety procedures while the search was conducted.

During the search, a landscaping crew working in the 6000 Block of Grant Street reported their work truck stolen. Based on witness descriptions of this alleged offender and the direction of travel, Officers expanded the search area. Burr Ridge Detectives located Keorkunian, who matched the descriptions given, in the 1700 Block of 55th Street in Western Springs. The stolen truck was located nearby.

Keorkunian was taken into custody and charged with Motor Vehicle Theft, a Class 2 felony, and Criminal Damage to Property, Theft, and Driving While License Revoked, all Class A Misdemeanors.

Keorkunian will be taken to the DuPage County Courthouse to await a bond hearing.
