No Spring Branch Pickup! 1933 National Quilt Contest Program Bunny Shop Hop Tomorrow! Artists Needed For PopCon!

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE VILLAGE NO LONGER PROVIDES A SPRING CURBSIDE BRUSH PROGRAM!

Please be advised that the Village is **not** providing a Spring curbside brush program. The Village now offers one consolidated Fall brush program, regularly scheduled in October. Unlimited yard waste and brush can be disposed of by Groot Industries from April 1 through December 15. This option is always available to you at no additional charge and is done without yard waste stickers. This service is part of the waste hauling franchise agreement for Burr Ridge residents. To dispose of brush and unlimited yard waste, please follow these guidelines: Brush and other landscape waste can be placed in biodegradable paper bags or inside containers not larger than 32 gallons. If using your own containers, you must obtain a free LANDSCAPE WASTE tag from Village Hall to identify the container's contents for the Groot truck drivers. Brush and material too bulky for a bag or container must be cut to less than 4 feet in length, and bundled with natural fiber twine. Bundles, bags, and containers of landscape waste placed at the curb cannot exceed 50 lbs. A cart that is larger than 32 gallons and which would be used only for landscape waste can be rented for \$5 per month from Groot Industries. All bundles, bags, and containers of landscape waste will be picked up on the day of your regular garbage pick-up, until December 15, at no charge. *If you have any questions, please contact the Village at (630) 654-8181.*
