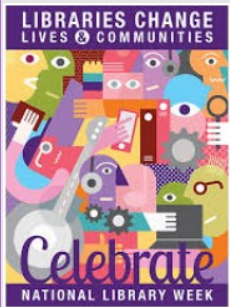
LAST Spring Brush Pickup Starts Monday, April 16th - 7:00 a.m. Village Wide

The Spring Brush Pickup is almost here! Beginning at 7:00 a.m. Monday, April 16th, Kramer Tree Specialists will move through the Village and begin picking up branches and brush placed appropriately at the curb by Village residents. Remember to place brush parallel to the street, and not too close to signs, fire hydrants, or other stationary objects. **This service is designed for residents doing their own "spring cleanup"**. Please note that this will be the **LAST** spring brush pickup, as we will be transitioning into a **FALL ONLY** brush pickup schedule. The Village Refuse Agreement provides for landscape waste pickup with bags, thus eliminating the need for brush pickups. Metra Looking to Revise BNSF Line Schedule Due To PTC - Input Requested!!



Metra's BNSF line is looking to revise its schedule due to Positive Train Control, (PTC) a federally mandated safety system. The PTC system is programmed to automatically stop a train if the engineer fails to obey a signal or exceeds the speed limit. Because of this new system, trains will have to undergo more checkpoints before turning – or "flipping" – a train back the other direction.
