With the increase in car thefts in neighboring communities and Burr Ridge, the Burr Ridge PD would like to remind everyone to keep their vehicles locked at all times, even in your own driveway. **Never leave your key fob or garage door openers in an unlocked vehicle**, as that gives thieves the opportunity to steal your vehicles, enter your garages and homes, and creates potentially dangerous situations. Remember that thieves are looking for cars that are an easy mark, and will randomly check car door handles to see if they are unlocked. Also, if you see unfamiliar vehicles driving slowly through the neighborhood or parking, they may be casing an area. Call the police and report it!!

Secretary Of State Mobile Driver Services Facility At Village Hall - Wed. August 15, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



The Secretary of State will once again be at the Village Hall with its Mobile Driver Services Facility on Wednesday, August 15, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. At the mobile facility, any Illinois resident can renew his/her license or ID up to one year in advance. The facility also offers vision screening, duplicate and/or corrected drivers' licenses, new ID cards and vehicle renewal stickers. Anyone over the age of 65 can obtain a free state ID that is good for life. Standard fees apply. The Mobile Facility does not offer road tests; anyone over the age of 75 is required to take a road test when renewing a drivers' license.
