Heavy Snowfall Predicted For This Weekend. Here Are Some Safety Tips For Home Snow Removal....

- Do not leave your snowblower unattended while it's running.
- Understand and know how your machine works before you use it.
- Don't hunch over while removing snow, and watch out for repetitive motions.
- Take breaks as needed - don't add extra stress and strain to your back and muscles!

Yep. We've been hearing it all week long. All the weather predictions that heavy snow is coming our way all weekend. The Village Snowplow Team will take care of the streets, but we know you still have walkways and driveways to clear. Here are a few snow removal safety tips to keep in mind when you're outside clearing the snow: Push heavy snow, don't lift it; Always turn off your snowblower to clear it, and DO NOT use your hands; Know how to use your snowblower properly, and DON'T leave it unattended while it's running; DON'T hunch over while removing snow, and watch out for repetitive motions; take breaks as needed! Break up the job, don't try to do it all at once - your back and muscles don't need all that extra stress and strain. Be safe out there, and stay warm! Spring WILL get here - eventually.
