Snow Removal Season Is Upon Us!! Here's a Few Things That Bear Repeating!!



With the wintry weather upon us, the Village Snowplow Crew will be out in force! As a resident, there's a few things you should know to help make sure your streets are plowed as cleanly as possible: 1. Residents and plowing contractors must avoid shoveling and/or blowing snow into the roadway - it's actually illegal to do so. 2. Private plow operators who are observed pushing snow into the roadway can be towed or ticketed. 3. Parking on Village streets is prohibited during snow-fall events of 2" or greater. Cars parked on the street during these events will be ticketed or towed. 4. When a plow is approaching, please stay back from the roadway, and especially keep children away from the roadway as the plow approaches. For more information, go to: www.burr-ridge.gov
