ComEd to Allow Smart Meter Deferrals While Residents Seek Permanent Opt-Outs



With the upcoming installation of Smart Meters throughout Burr Ridge, some residents are concerned regarding any RF radiation emissions, even though the level of RF radiation emanating from Smart Meters is well below FCC standards. There is a process in which homeowners can postpone or "defer" the installation of their Smart Meter. A Resolution has been passed by the Village Board to encourage sponsorship of legislation that would lead to customers being able to permanently opt-out of the Smart Meters.
