

## Drone Regulation Addressed By FAA, Burr Ridge Has Drone Statement




New drone rules from the Federal Aviation Administration limit small unmanned commercial aircraft to 55 pounds and require that they be used in daylight, but also raise the ceiling limit of flight from 200 to 400 feet. FAA rules also call for the drone to remain in a visual line of sight of the person operating the flight controls or of an observer. While the State of Illinois is still working on its drone regulation policies, the Village of Burr Ridge does have a "Drone Statement" in place, one which reminds operators to be mindful of others' privacy and rights.
