## Secretary Of State Mobile Driver Services At Village Hall - Wed. March 14 - 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



The Secretary of State will once again be at the Village Hall with its Mobile Driver Services Facility on Wednesday, March 14, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. At the mobile facility, any Illinois resident can renew his/her license or ID up to one year in advance. The facility also offers vision screening, duplicate and/or corrected drivers' licenses, new ID cards and vehicle renewal stickers. Anyone over the age of 65 can obtain a free state ID that is good for life. Standard fees apply. The Mobile Facility does not offer road tests; anyone over the age of 75 is required to take a road test when renewing a drivers' license.
