

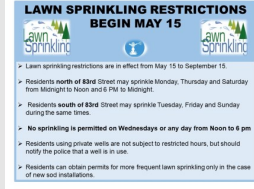

Lawn Sprinkling Restrictions Begin on Tuesday, May 15th for Burr Ridge



The Annual Lawn Sprinkling restrictions for the spring/summer season will begin on Tuesday, May 15th. Residents north of 83rd street may sprinkle Monday, Thursday, and Saturday from Midnight to noon, and 6pm to Midnight. Residents south of 83rd street may sprinkle Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday from Midnight to noon, and 6pm to Midnights. No sprinkling is permitted on Wednesdays or any day from noon to 6pm. Residents using private wells are not subject to these restrictions, but need to notify the police that they are on a well system. Residents can obtain permits for more frequent lawn sprinkling in the cases of new sod installations. Restrictions are in effect until September 15th. **Tip:** 1 inch of water a week is all you need for a healthy lawn!

National Bike to Work Week is May 14 - 18, Bike To Work Day Is Friday, May 18th...Join In The Fun!



Hurray for May - it's National Bike Month! And, National Bike to Work Week is May 14 - 18, with National Bike to Work Day being May 18th. Planning to ride this week? Great! Here are a few tips you need to know to help keep you safe: Bicyclists should always ride in the same direction as traffic, and stay as close to the right as practical, avoiding potholes, grates, gravel, etc. on the shoulder; Bicyclists must obey the same traffic laws as motorists, stopping at stop signs, waiting at traffic lights, etc.; Ride single file on busy streets and when cars are around - riding two or three across is not only dangerous, but inconsiderate - Drivers need three feet to safely pass a bicyclist on the road, it's the law! Let's give each other the space to be safe! Use the correct hand signals when riding - let others know your intentions on the road. And of course, **WEAR YOUR HELMET!! ALWAYS!!**

Village Of Burr Ridge Outside Work Restrictions Reminder...



Just a friendly reminder that the Village of Burr Ridge Outside Work Restrictions for outside construction and maintenance work are in effect as follows: Mondays through Fridays - 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for both; Saturdays - 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for both; Sundays and Holidays - outside construction is prohibited, but outside maintenance is allowed from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. These restrictions were adopted by the Village Board in November of 2017. Violation of these Outside Work Restrictions may result in a Code Violation, which will result in fines. **Note:** Residents working on their own properties are exempt from these restrictions.
