Mosquito Abatement Sprays Combat West Nile Virus in Burr Ridge



Following an early August discovery of West Nile Virus from a mosquito in DuPage County, the Village has had several extra mosquito abatement sprays to combat the virus and reduce the mosquito population in the area. Clarke Environmental sprayed for mosquitos on August 18th and 25th, and September 1. Cook County had previously sprayed on August 2 and August 7. To date, there have been no more findings of West Nile Virus, but we will keep you posted if that should change.
