FALL BRUSH PICKUP STARTS MONDAY, OCTOBER 9th



- Branches removed by contractors are **NOT** accepted. The program is intended to assist residents who perform their own work.
- Branches may not exceed 8" in diameter.
- Branches must be stacked neatly on the parkway, oriented parallel to the street, and 3 feet away from any stationary objects such as trees, mailboxes, fire hydrants, etc.
- Branches must not be tied with string, wire, etc. Branches must be free of wire, staples, nails or metal of any kind.
- Root balls, stumps, lumber, debris, rocks, grasses, or any non-woody material will not be accepted.
- Branches and twigs shorter than 18 inches should be placed in a yard waste bag for removal by your waste hauler.
- Branches must not be placed in the parkway more than three weeks before the chipping program for your area begins.
- Branches must be in the parkway by **NO LATER THAN 7:00 AM** on the first day of pickup, **October 9th**.
Once the contractor has progressed past your street, they will not be able to return.
