ComEd’s Delivery Service Charge to Decrease

Available for review at the Village Hall is a letter from Michael Guerra, Vice President of External Affairs and Large Customer Solutions for Commonwealth Edison, indicating that ComEd’s delivery service charge will decrease by about \$1.00 on the average monthly residential bill starting in January 2016, due to lower than anticipated costs of implementing their Smart Grid Program. It is anticipated that Smart meters will begin to be installed in Burr Ridge sometime in 2016.

March Building Report

Available for review at the Village Hall is the Building Report for the month of March, prepared by Building & Zoning Assistant Julie Tejkowski. The report shows the following building permits issued during the month:

- 0 New Single Family Residential
- 4 Residential Additions/Alterations in the amount of \$255,975
- 1 New Non-Residential in the amount of \$6,542,562
- 3 Non-Residential Additions/Alterations in the amount of \$1,074,284

A year-to-date grand total of 27 permits were issued for a year-to-date construction value of \$13,117,065.
