Tribune News Article Regarding Faulty Water Meters in Tinley Park

You may have noticed that, in Thursday's *Chicago Tribune*, there was an article critical of the Village of Tinley Park regarding faulty "smart meters" that have in some instances overcharged residents (article available at the Village Hall for review). Please be aware that the meters purchased by Tinley Park are manufactured by a British firm called Severn Trent. These meters were among the first smart meters on the market and were installed as early as 2002. Please be aware that the water meters the Village of Burr Ridge uses is manufactured by a company called Sensus. There is no documented evidence that their meters have the problems that the Severn Trent meters have. Although I'm sure once residents read this article, they will begin to question our meter replacement program. We have asked our meter company for additional information on whether or not their meters have experienced any prior difficulties. In the meantime, I liken this situation to Ford Motor Company announcing a recall of their vehicles and people assuming that it somehow has something to do with the Lexus they own.
