**STP Grant Applications**

As the Board will recall, the Village submitted grant applications for both the County Line Road and German Church Road sidewalks. We also filed an application for the resurfacing of Burr Ridge Parkway, from County Line Road to Bridewell Drive. There is a total of \$10,000,000 available in STP grant funds. Unfortunately, there are over \$48.6 million in application requests (see attached Application Log). We should know by

sometime in early October whether or not we will be successful in receiving any grant funds for these projects.

**Village Attorney to Hold Hourly Rates for Another Year**

Attached please find a letter from Scott Uhler, of Klein Thorpe and Jenkins, indicating that they will retain their current hourly rates through June 30, 2016, but will ask for a moderate rate increase of \$5.00 per hour on July 1, 2016. Their last rate increase was back in July of 2011.

Dear Mayor Straub and Trustees:



In this regard, please be advised that, notwithstanding signs that economic conditions are, ever so slowly, starting to improve, and notwithstanding that our firm's overhead costs (rent, salaries, employee benefits, etc.) continue to rise, our firm has elected to once again "freeze" our rates for legal services rendered through June 30, 2016. Our records show our last rate increase was July 1, 2011. This means that the rates that have been in effect for the Village will remain in effect, with no increase, through June 30, 2016. Please note, however, we would propose a modest rate increase of five dollars per hour be implemented, effective July 1, 2016.

# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The big news in Springfield this week was yesterday's failed vote to override Governor Rauner's veto of the AFSCME bill by the House. The motion to override would have required 71 "Yes" votes for passage, the exact number of Democrats in the House, but only received 68. If passed, the arbitration bill would have sent labor talks with state employee unions to binding arbitration.

The House also narrowly failed to override a number of other vetoes and will not convene again for three weeks. The Senate was not in session this week, but will return to Springfield next Wednesday, September 9.

## **Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Legislation**

Last week, the House adopted an amendment to [HB 4149](#) which would make appropriations to allow IDOT to distribute MFT revenue to municipalities, counties, and road districts to compensate for expenditures made in July, August, and September. The amended bill remains in the House on 3rd Reading. The state is withholding the hundreds of thousands of dollars collected from the motor fuel tax since July 1. Many local governments rely on monthly MFT distributions and have had to delay projects that had already been started, as well as postpone the start of needed projects which may now be pushed to a future construction season.


