Village Receives Tentative Grant Funding Approval for the Burr Ridge Parkway Resurfacing Project

I am pleased to report that DMMC Transportation Technical Committee today recommended approval of our application for agreement to resurface Burr Ridge Parkway from County Line Road to Bridewell Drive. The cost of the project is \$724,750.00, with the STP Grant in the amount of \$507,325.00. Unfortunately, our request for additional funds for the County Line Road Sidewalk Project was once again rejected. The recommendation of the DMMC Transportation Technical Committee will be presented to the Executive Board and Board of Directors in November for final approval.
