



Join the Village's reforestation efforts by ordering trees for fall planting in your yard. The trees are purchased through the Suburban Tree Consortium (STC), which is comprised of 30 municipalities in the western suburbs who banded together to contract with Wilson Nurseries of Hampshire, Illinois. Although there is no guarantee that accompanies the trees, mortality within the consortium has been approximately 1 % in recent years.

Because the trees will be dormant at the time of delivery, conditions will be ideal for the development of a healthy root system. However, since deliveries are not until late October, residents are urged to plant their trees promptly after receiving them to avoid any danger of freezing or drying. Since the trees are grown locally, they are well-adjusted to soil conditions. Also, since they are balled and burlapped, the trees adapt more readily to their new location and do not require extensive pruning.

Please remember that under the provisions of the Village's tree regulations, a permit must be obtained if any of the trees purchased through this program are to be planted in the parkway. There is no fee for the permit; however, your application should be approved before you accept delivery.

As shown on the order form, the following trees will be available for purchase. Some quantities are limited and are first come, first serve.

2" Autumn Blaze Maple - \$203

Autumn Blaze maple trees boast both beautiful fall foliage and a shapely form.¹ The branching pattern is dense and ascending, and they sport a rounded to oval crown. Maturity comes quickly: They can grow as fast as 3 feet per year under the right conditions. They come into their own in fall, as [their fall color](#) is a brilliant orange-red.

2" Swamp White Oak - \$234

Quercus bicolor, commonly called swamp white oak, is a medium sized, deciduous tree with a broad, rounded crown and a short trunk which typically grows at a moderate rate to a height of 50-60' (sometimes larger).

2" Royal Raindrops Crabapple - \$182

Eye-popping magenta pink blooms, deep purple cutleaf foliage, sparkling red fruits and bright fall color give all-season appeal to this easy-care flowering ornamental.

Order deadline is Wednesday Sept 30, delivery will be scheduled for sometime in October. There is a delivery fee of \$10/tree. Tree delivery will begin after October 16th and trees will only be delivered to the driveway. Residents will be contacted prior to delivery. We cannot make arrangements for special deliveries at another time. Delivery may be delayed if it rains. If this happens, residents who ordered trees will be notified by telephone and given another delivery date.
