Illinois Signage Rules for Polling Places:



- Signs may not be posted within 100 feet of a designated polling place. (campaign free zone)
- Signs may not be posted within 100 horizontal feet of an indoor polling location. (campaign free zone)
- Election Judges have the right to enforce the signage location rules, and shall do so.
- Signs must be removed in a timely manner following the poll closings, as a courtesy to the Village.

Temporary Signage Restrictions

The Village of Burr Ridge Temporary Sign Placement Restrictions are as follows:



- All signs must be placed 16 feet from the curb or edge of the pavement, and must be placed on private property - with the owners' permission.
- Signs are not allowed on the public parkways.
- **Exception:** Signs are permitted in public rights-of-way between the hours of 9am and 6pm on Saturdays and Sundays.
- Inappropriately placed signs in the Village will be picked up by Code Enforcement and will be disposed of after seven days. You may come to the Village Hall to retrieve your signs before they are disposed of.

Village of Burr Ridge - Permitted Sign Use

PERMITTED



Outside of Right of Way (Sidewalk)



20+ feet from the roadway

NOT PERMITTED



Inside of Right of Way (Sidewalk)



Less than 20+ feet from the roadway

Exceptions: Garage and Estate Sales signs on weekends between 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. Must be picked up afterwards.

Inappropriately placed signs may be picked up by Code Enforcement. Retrieval of removed signs is available at the Village Hall.
